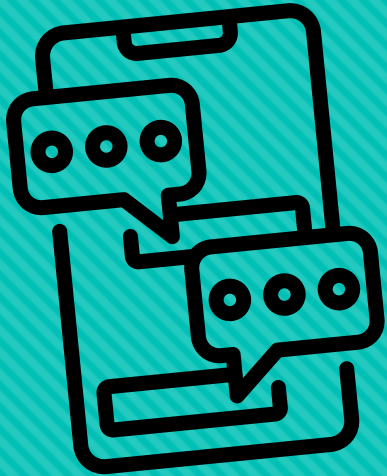

And the answer is ...

Computers use 'bits' to represent information, **bits are binary digits** that can be either in the state '1' or '0'. Binary means two. Text messages, images, and voice recordings sent via a smartphone, are transformed into huge sequences of strings of ones and zeroes (binary codes) through the air, over radio waves.
