

September is here & so are the acorns

Look at these photos. Compose 10 questions about acorns.



Some possible questions:

- What are acorns?
- Where do they come from?
- Can you eat acorns?
- Why are some green?
- Why do they have caps?
- Why are the caps different?
- Why are the acorns different sizes?
- Why are they different shapes?
- Why are some stuck together at the caps, like twins?
- What grows from acorns?
- Can you plant an acorn? How do you do it?
- Why do squirrels and other animals collect acorns?

Extension Activities:

Play a game. If students have questions not on this list, they can earn points.

Or, they can pick one of their questions to read aloud. If no classmate asked their question, they earn a point.

Allow students to pick a question and do an internet search for the answer. Or, take questions home and ask an adult for help to answer the question (s) without looking anything up on the internet.
