




## Explain this School Humor



Parallel lines never insect each other and always the same distance apart. Perpendicular lines always intersect each other at right angles.

<u>Stages in the Life Cycle of a Butterfly</u> – **egg** (require specific plants, called host plants to lay eggs, about 200-500 eggs), **larva** (when eggs hatch, tiny caterpillars begin feeding and growing), **pupa** (finds a protected spot, molts, forms an encasement, spin a silken cocoon to form a chrysalis), **adult** (splits the case open, hangs upside down for stretching and drying its wings, once wings are dried, adult flies off to feed, find a mate, start cycle over)







The word *table* is "polysemous" (having more than one possible meaning) That means "table" points to different concepts.

The term eighth refers to an eighth of an ounce or 3.5 grams. 1/8 is a fraction-one of 8 equal parts.



What sort of music do frogs like?



Hip Hop-formally known as disco rap is music that originated in the Bronx borough of New York City in the 1970s. It has a strong, rhythmic beat and usually a rapping vocal track.

Rock n' Roll comes from Rock Music evolved in the early 1950s and got its name by literally "rocking" and "rolling." (phrase used by sailors to describe the motion of the ship.) Subgenres include classic rock, punk rick, pop rock, etc.
