Facts about this storm

•Thunderstorms brought damaging wind gusts to parts of northern Illinois during the evening of July 14th.

•One tornado with a preliminary rating of EFO touched down in Warrenville and tracked into Wheaton before subsiding in Glen Ellyn.

•A concentrated area of intense straight-line wind damage occurred in Elk Grove Village. Winds there were estimated to be as strong as 80 mph.

Q: Can tornadoes destroy trees?

A: The higher the wind speed, the more likely trees will fall. Once tornadoes reach a level EF2, research shows that the 115-150 mph wind speeds will likely uproot or destroy trees.
