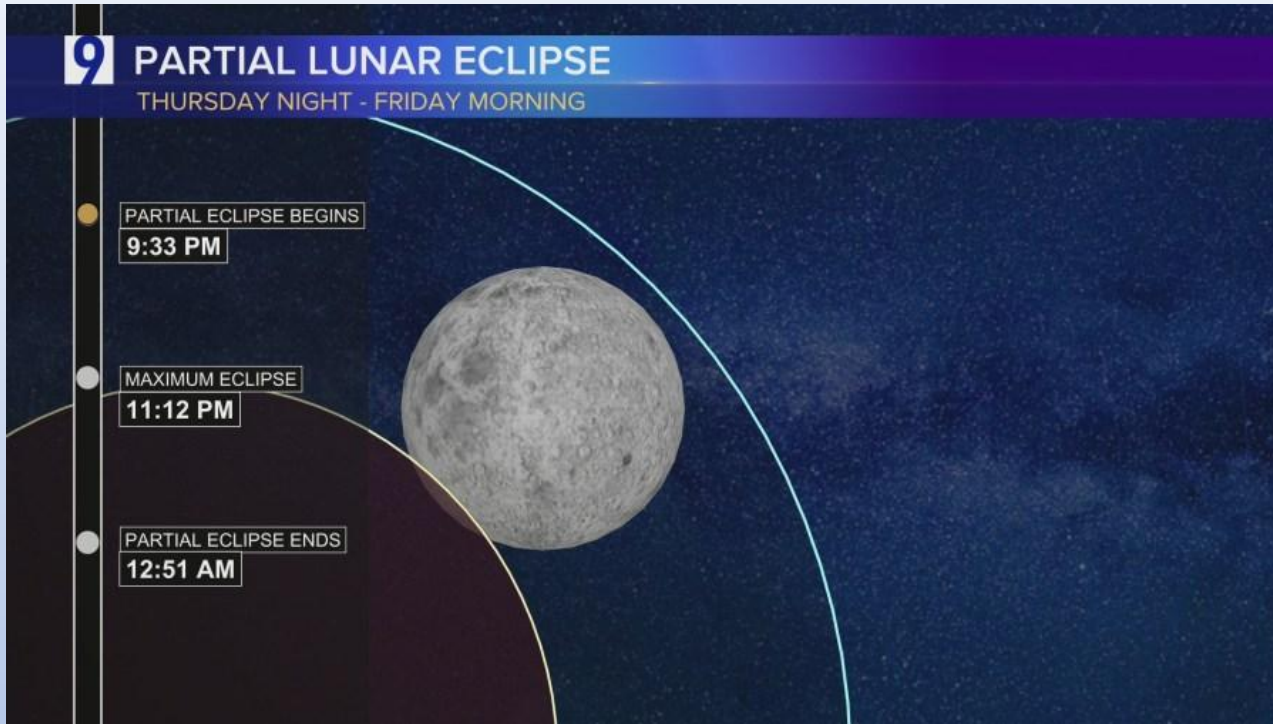


A STEM Summer!
